For these reasons, the preservation of memory is even more a very topical issue today and on which it is not possible to ignore. The problem of risk management in World Heritage sites is of great value because it consists of aspects ranging from the

pure organizational management of the heritage to the preservation and protection of monuments that by definition have the role of having to be protected and enjoyed. It therefore seems necessary to highlight not only the risks in their widest sense, but also the methods and good practices of management and enhancement that have allowed the good itself to be preserved, known and lived.
